# 5. Old Business

- a) Enrollment Updates (155 from PP-5)
- b) 2024-2025 Staffing : School admin will receive staffing allocations on Monday, May 6th. Teachers will receive their notice of assignment on Wednesday, May 8th. The first round of permanent teaching postings will go live that day as well.
- c) 2024-2025 Class Configurations: Paula reviewed the proposed configuration for the 2024-2025 school year. We will continue to have 8 classes from PP-5.
- d) SSP Updates: Paula reviewed the reflections from our Cycle 2 strategies. As a staff, we will be developing our strategies for Cycle 3 in the coming week.
- e) LM3: Our grade 3 students will write the Provincial reading, writing and math assessment on the week of May 13th-17th.
- f) Student Support Block 3: As a staff, we worked to select students who require additional support in guided reading, writing, math, assistive technology, and resource. These students will receive Tier 2 intervention from now until the end of the school year (Cycle 3).

#### f) SSP Goals and Strategies for 2024-2025

<u>Literacy</u>: We will improve achievement in literacy for each of our students, with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry.

<u>Math</u>: We will improve achievement in mathematics for each of our students, with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry

<u>Well-Being</u>: We will improve well-being at our school for each of our students, with a specific focus on our students of African and/or Mi'kmaw/Indigenous ancestry.

\* Specific strategies will be developed during our upcoming Professional Learning Day on October 11, 2024.

## g) Core Phonics Surveys

All teachers from grades 1-5 are completing a CPS with the support of Holly Lake. The data from these surveys will be used to guide next instructional steps for phonological and phonemic awareness. We will continue to use the UFLI scope and sequence and lessons in all classes.

## h) NEW - Elementary Literacy Support Teacher

Reviewed the role of the ELST (small group intervention, Reading Recovery, student-centred coaching)

All classes currently have support from the ELST.

## i) Student Support Plan

Reviewed the process for selecting students for resource, ELST small group intervention, RR, guided reading and guided math (through UIT). Student support is provided on a short-cycle basis.

# j) 24-25 SAC Funding

Each year the SAC receives \$5000 plus \$1 per student to support our Student Success Planning (goals in math, literacy and well-being). Teachers often submit proposals to access funding; SAC votes for approval. Funding has not been received yet for this school year; it usually arrives in early December.
