Open House

First Day of School

The first day of school is Thursday, September 5th. Teachers will be on duty at 7:40 am. If you are choosing to drop off your child that day, please refrain from using the bus loop. Your child's teacher will be in contact with you prior to our open house, to introduce themselves and to let you know where your child's classroom is.

October 1 Treaty Day (Schools Open) As you likely already know, a provincial lunch program is set to begin in HRCE schools that include elementary school grades (pre-primary/primary to Grade 5) this October.

Once the ordering window opens, you will also be able to order your child(ren)'s meals on this website. We will keep you updated on when this happens for our school.

We will not be using Healthy Hunger as this provincial program will replace it. Please send snacks and lunch with your child every day until the lunch program starts.

Lunch Hour Changes

We have made a small change to our lunch hour for this year. All students will eat their lunch from 11:30-11:55 and then go outside to play from 11:55-12:20. We will no longer have a "split lunch".

Cell Phones 📵

As you may be aware, the Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development has recently announced a Provincial Directive on Cell Phones in Schools. This directive recognizes the importance of maintaining a learning environment that is free from unnecessary distractions so that students can focus, feel safe and be successful in school.

As a school, we welcome this announcement as we know from experience that cell phones and other related devices are often a source of distraction. They are also known to contribute to feelings of anxiety, can be used to bully and negatively impact students' overall feelings of well-being.

What does this mean for students at our school this year?

Students may still carry a cell phone to and from school, if necessary.

• Should a child require a cell phone for medical reasons, they will continue to use it for this purpose.

- Students in Grades PP-5 may not use their cell phone at any time during the day.
- At no time are cell phones permitted in washrooms.

• Parents and Guardians will need to call the office (902-479-4230) to pass along important messages.

• Bus transportation is an extension of the school day and subject to the Provincial Code of Conduct Policy. Personal use of mobile devices while waiting for, or riding the bus needs to align with the expectations. Students may not record or take pictures while on the bus.

<u>SAC</u>

School Advisory Councils play an important role in supporting student success at the school community level. A School Advisory Council is an advisory body to the school principal on a range of issues related to the school and the school system. Membership can vary, but generally consists of the school principal, parents, teachers, and other community members.

We ask that all families take care in not sending snack or lunch items that contain nuts of any kind. This helps to ensure that our students with allergies are safe and healthy.

Breakfast Program

Thanks to our wonderful parent volunteer, Ashley Cassibo, we are able to offer a breakfast program at our school. This program is for all students, regardless of if they have had breakfast at home before school or not. If you are able to spare an hour or two a week, we are always looking for volunteers to help with this important program. Volunteer time can be very flexible and does not need to be before school. Please reach out to the main office if you are able to lend a hand. :) Our breakfast program will begin on the first day of school.

Drop-off Loop 🚗

A reminder to families that the drop off loop must not be entered when school buses are present. For your child's safety, please allow them to exit your vehicle on the playground side, rather than into the road where cars are moving. We also ask that parents do not park their vehicle and get out as this can quickly cause congestion to form.

<u>Safe Arrival</u>

A reminder to **please use the safe arrival process to let us know if your child/ren will be absent**. <u>**Please do not call the school to report an absence**</u>. To report your student absent, you can use any of the following methods:

1. PowerSchool Parent/Student Portal

Parents/guardians can log in to <u>https://sishrsb.ednet.ns.ca/public/</u> to access the SchoolMessenger website to report future absences.

2. SchoolMessenger App

Parents/guardians can download the SchoolMessenger app for Android and iOS devices and use their username and password for the PowerSchool Portal.

3. Toll-Free Number

Parents/guardians can call 1-833-582-6940 to report future absences using an automated system. All three methods are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Absences can be reported at any time before the start of school on the day the student will be absent. Up to five consecutive absences can be recorded at once.

Please report your child's absence no later than 8:00 am on the day of their absence.

Purple Tag Program for Bussing

All students in grades pre-primary to 2 **must be accompanied by an** <u>adult</u> at the bus stop before and after school. Children in pp-2 will have a purple tag put onto their backpack to identify them.
