What does the commitment look like?

**General Committee Members:** The committee meets virtually monthly and helps plan events and fundraisers (brainstorming and logistic planning). You'll be able to choose how involved you get. Attending all meetings or events is not required. Much of the communication happens via email.

Chair/Co-Chair: The chair/co-chair will chair meetings, organize the H&S committee, and communicate between the school and the committee. There is no defined way to do this; chairs can divide work as they wish and determine how much time they want to offer. There will be support from the outgoing chair. You do not have to have been involved with H&S previously to take this on. There is always room for new ideas and ways of doing things!

Mabel's Labels Lead: HES is set up to receive 20% of any purchase that chooses to support HES at the time of sale. This is an ongoing fundraiser – year-round – year to year. We need someone to market the information, monitor the school account, and request cheques when the amount gets to a certain point. The company provides marketing communications, so creating anything is unnecessary. The minimum requirement would be no more than 3 hours total over the whole year, and it is up to the individual when you want to complete these tasks.
